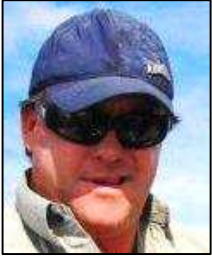

ATTENTION ALL CURRENT FINANCIAL MEMBERS

Once you have completed your \$60 membership renewal form and sent it off, you will receive a receipt back in the mail, with your membership card, information pack and 2011/2012 Point Score Participant Forms. Please **FILL THEM IN** and send off to Dave Fenech the Recorder so you can be registered for the 2010/2011 Point Score. For more info on the point score, feel free to contact Dave:

If you also require a JB GFC CARBON POINT SCORE BOOK, please tick the box on your membership renewal and make sure you pay the additional \$15 so it can be sent to you

NOTE- If you intend on Fishing Tournaments, many of them require that you have this book when you attend the Weigh Station to weigh fish or hand in tag cards. **YOU MAY** be disqualified without it, so please get a book if you need one **BEFORE** you fish any Tournaments. This book is also required for our new point score system.

Your boat must be registered with JB GFC to be eligible to receive a **BOOK** (sole members are not eligible unless special reason). A \$15 fee is payable to the club for any new book.

To be eligible for point score:

1. You must be a current financial member of the club to be considered for point score. If you have not paid the \$60 renewal and have not been checked off as paid by the Recorder, any claims will be made null and void.
2. You must complete the Point score Participant form. This details critical information which is required to be entered into the system before you claim any points. This includes Members fishing the JB GFC Okuma Whitesands Tournament who intend on claiming those points for our club and Southern Zone point score.
3. Any capture or tag cards must be signed off, then a JB GFC Club Book slip filled out and sent to:

Dave will then record your capture and send off any applicable tag cards on to Fisheries.

4. Any "Other Waters" **captures** must also be signed off by an Official Club Weighmaster from the Club in which Port you are fishing from, and then once again posted into Dave for recording.
5. If you provide an email address, an update on the club, Southern Zone and other waters point score will be emailed to you at the end of each month. Updates will also be posted on our website:

6. The Southern Zone Cock O' Walk and the NSW Waters Point Score System will work off current NSW GFA Guidelines and Rules. These can be found at:

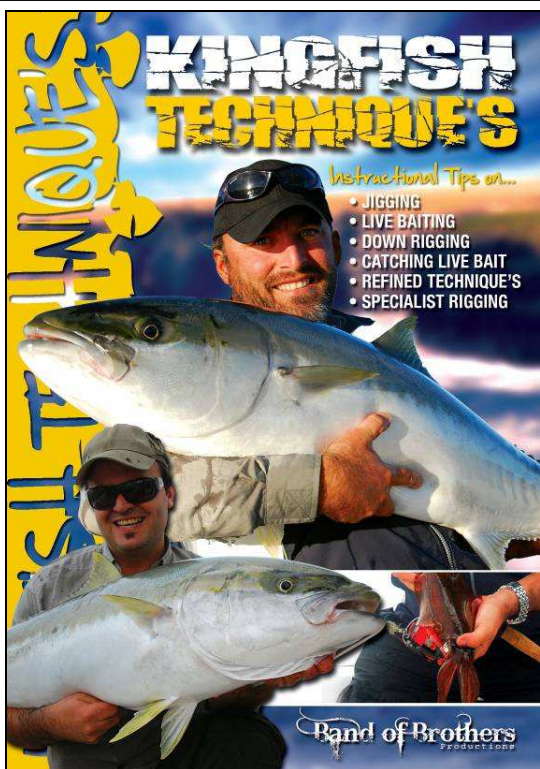

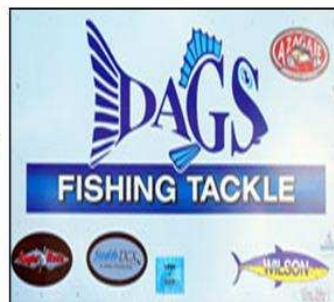
