

## **CATCH MEASURE AND RELEASE RULES at 21/08/2024**

A "Catch , Measure and Release " for both Juniors and Seniors with date stamped photo of fish on supplied Brag mat ,will also be run concurrently to the monthly weigh ins and be able to be fished 24/7 everyday of the month prior to weigh in.

It will also enable juniors to use the same photos to upload to the Junior GFAA online tournament that is open all year around

### **Rules for Catch, Measure and Release are below:**

At the beginning of Each month the committee will state a "token item" that must be included in the Catch and release photos , this item must be in the pic presented to the committee the following weigh in.

1 x DPI Brag mat will be provided to all registered members who fish the FFG events , this will be limited to one per registered member , checked off list once received , brag mats can be purchased if Mats lost after first provided for free , please organise a brag mat from the club, prior to fishing the "Catch , Measure and Release" category.

Fish can be caught from any Location and must be released healthy.

### **Rules for Catch, Measure and Release**

Fish can be caught 24/7 over the month from any location and must be released healthy. Anglers are encouraged to Catch, Measure and Release any species that are included in our Mystery Catch and Release list below, only photos containing the Item of the month and of your longest Mystery fish taken during the month on the supplied Brag mat need to be presented to the weighmaster at the monthly weigh in.

Longest of the Mystery Species will win for Junior and Senior

A species for that month will be pulled out of a hat at the weigh in and that species will count for the month leading up to the weigh in .

**Eligible Species for this Category , Legal Length -Bream, Snapper, Flathead, Salmon,Tailor,trevally**

If there are no winners after the mystery Species is picked then competing anglers who have photo evidence to produce as per rules above ,will be put into a hat and a winner randomly drawn.
